

Notice of application

Cascade Power GP Ltd. has filed an application for an order permitting the sharing of records not available to the public.

Proceeding 29964 Application 29964-A001

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, in accordance with Section 3(5)(a) of the Fair, Efficient and Open Competition Regulation, must publish notice of an application filed pursuant to Section 3(3) of the Fair, Efficient and Open Competition Regulation.

Cascade Power GP Ltd. (Cascade Power), Cascade Power Project Limited Partnership (Cascade LP), Kineticor Resource Corp. (Kineticor Resource), Kineticor Asset Management LP (Kineticor Asset) and URICA Energy Real Time Ltd. (URICA Real Time) hold Order 29100-D02-2024,¹ that permits these parties to share records relating to non-public price, quantity and availability information pertaining to the Cascade Power Plant (asset IDs CAS1 and CAS2) with respect to CAS1 and CAS2's participation in the Alberta electricity market. The sharing of records is necessary for URICA Real Time to assist Cascade Power in providing 24-hour real-time dispatch-desk service for operational energy market services and energy restatements for events at the Cascade Power Plant as required by the Independent System Operator rules.

Application

On April 4, 2025, Cascade Power submitted an application notifying the Commission of changes to the information within approved Application 29100-A001. Specifically, that the maximum capability of each unit, CAS1 and CAS2, has increased from 450 megawatts (MW) to 466 MW, while the commercial and information sharing arrangements, internal compliance programs, and representations remain materially unchanged. The increases to the generating units results in the Cascade Power Plant generation capability increasing from 900 MW to 932 MW. The current application requests that the Commission replace the existing preferential sharing of records order with a new order confirming the continued approval for sharing of records for CAS1 and CAS2, including non-public energy price, volume pairs and available capability, between the parties, from as early as approved to June 1, 2029.

Hearing and parties to the proceeding

Upon receipt of an application, Section 3(5) of the *Fair*, *Efficient and Open Competition Regulation* requires the Commission to publish notice of the application and hold, in private, a hearing or other proceeding involving the market participant that filed the application and the Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA), if the MSA chooses to participate in the hearing or

other proceeding. Accordingly, the parties in this proceeding will be limited to Cascade Power and the MSA.

A copy of the application is filed with the Commission by Cascade Power and is not available to the public.

Publicly available information regarding this proceeding is available through the AUC website at www.auc.ab.ca by logging in to the eFiling System and entering Proceeding 29964. To receive notification about this proceeding, please ensure you are registered as an observer in this proceeding.

Intervention in the proceeding

If the MSA wishes to intervene in this proceeding, it must submit a statement of intent to participate to the Commission by the participation deadline of 4 p.m. on April 28, 2025.

The submission should provide an indication as to whether the MSA supports or objects to the application and the supporting rationale. The information provided should also indicate whether the MSA requires an evidentiary process including information requests and filing of evidence. If the MSA is represented by another party, the contact information for the representative should be included.
