

Notice Amendment to code of conduct compliance plan

Proceeding 30012 EQUS REA Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application to amend EQUS REA Ltd.'s compliance plan pursuant to Section 32 of the *Code of Conduct Regulation* to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

EQUS, as an electric distributor, has filed an application requesting approval for minor revisions to its *Code of Conduct Regulation* compliance plan. The revisions include necessary modifications to account for arrangements where EQUS performs default supplier or self-supply retailer obligations for other Rural Electrification Associations, revising references from the Regulated Rate Option to the Rate of Last Resort, updating references to revised job titles at EQUS, and correcting other minor definitional and typographical errors where applicable. These changes necessitate a revision to its compliance plan under Section 32 of the *Code of Conduct Regulation*.

Written submissions are due May 12, 2025.
