

## Notice of application Bright Meadows Solar Project

# Revolve Meadows Solar GP Inc. has filed an application for a solar power plant and interconnection located in the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10

Proceeding 29985 Application 29985-A001

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant development application in Proceeding 29985. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can request to participate and provide input to the AUC before it makes its decision.

You can request to participate by registering and filing a statement of intent to participate by June 11, 2025.

Revolve Meadows Solar GP Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Revolve Renewable Power Corp., has applied for approval to construct and operate a 15.7-megawatt solar power plant, designated as the Bright Meadows Solar Project, and to connect the power plant to the FortisAlberta Inc. distribution system, under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.

The project would be located on the southeast quarter of Section 29, Township 46, Range 27, west of the Fourth Meridian, on approximately 119 acres (48 hectares) of privately owned land, approximately six kilometres east of the village of Ma-Me-O Beach in the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10. The project area is shown in the map included with this notice.
