

Notice 2023 default rate tariff and regulated rate tariff Rider C3 compliance filing

Proceeding 30081 Direct Energy Regulated Services

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for Direct Energy Regulated Services' (DERS) 2023 default rate tariff and regulated rate tariff Rider C3 compliance filing to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

DERS has filed an application requesting approval to dispose the Rider C3 over-collected amount of \$264,549 as part of its upcoming 2024 bad debt deferral application, which it expects to file in the summer of 2025. The rider was in place from September 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024, to dispose of the balance in the 2023 bad debt and late payment charge deferral accounts.

Written submissions are due June 12, 2025.
