Collisard Power Station Project

Collisard Power L.P. has filed applications for the Collisard Power Station Project in Red Deer County

Proceeding 30450

Applications 30450-A001 and 30450-A002

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant and substation development applications in Proceeding 30450. If you feel you may be affected by these applications, you can request to participate and provide input to the AUC before it makes its decision.

You can request to participate by registering and filing a statement of intent to participate by February 6, 2026.

Collisard Power L.P., a wholly owned subsidiary of Northland Power Inc., has applied to construct and operate the Collisard Power Station Project that would consist of a 120-megawatt natural gas power plant and a substation. The project would be located within Red Deer County, approximately five kilometres south of Benalto, within Legal Subdivision 2 of Section 2, Township 38, Range 3, west of the Fifth Meridian. The applications were made under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.
